## Notes About IV Treatment

Welcome! If you have decided to receive IV treatment, here are some important notes:

- There are no appointments for IV treatment. Once Dr. Burt or Arthur Berkson have recommended IV treatment in your visit, you can come any time during the windows of time scheduled (see back for IV room schedule).
- Sign in at the front desk and walk to the IV room in back. If seats are not available, notify the front desk to put you on a waiting list and have a seat in the lobby.
- Alpha Lipoic Acid IVs usually take 30 min - one hour, depending on your vein.
- Glutathione is generally a 15-minute IV
- Vitamin C can run from 1-2 hours, depending on the strength. A G6PD enzyme test is required (blood test) prior to the first Vitamin C IV to determine sensitivity to high doses of Vitamin C
- Please wear comfortable clothing. Bring a snack and a sweater if you tend to be cold.
- Always eat before you come for an IV. A combination of a protein and a carb works well.
- Like other supplements, IVs are not reimbursed by health insurance.
- If you have questions about your IV, please ask our medical staff.
